**MODULE 3** 5th Jan – 8th February 2026

6 ECTS **PROJECT & PROGRAMME PLANNING & CONTROL**  
Applies goal directed methods & tracking, aimed at achieving future sustainable benefits through projects and programmes.

**MODULE 4** 16th Feb – 22nd March 2026

6 ECTS **PROJECT LEADERSHIP & GOVERNANCE**  
Raises awareness of the importance of effective leadership, having clear roles, responsibilities and appropriate governance structures in place.

6 ECTS **PROGRAMME VALUE, RISK AND DECISION MAKING**  
Explains how to develop business models and value solutions that are implemented through programmes, with a focus on long term sustainable benefits.
